We are an inclusive, welcoming and vibrant Anglican parish in the centre of Winchester. We are committed to serving the community both locally and beyond. We see ourselves as pilgrims on a journey which we seek to share, and we believe that the root of all we seek to be, and do, is found in the love of God.

The parish has two church buildings. St Matthew's is a beautiful, intimate church dating back to the 12th century. It is open from 10 to 4 each weekday as well as for Sunday services. Recent building projects provided a kitchenette, an accessible toilet and a flower-arranging area. St Paul's is a spacious late Victorian church. Its recent renovation under the *Building for Life* project has levelled the floor and added two new toilets, a kitchen, a flower-arranging and utility room, an office and a gallery with a meeting room. It has created a magnificent and prayerful church which we hope will be at the service of the community for meetings, concerts and other events. As well as holding services, St Paul's is normally open every day from 9 to 5. The St Paul's site also contains the Parish Hall and Parish Rooms, together with an outdoor children's play area and a car park. These two buildings house a wide range of activities, from a pre-school to ballet classes. Because of St Paul's size and its broad community usage, the Site Manager will be based there, though he or she will also be responsible for the St Matthew's site.
