

St Paul's toddler group Covid guidelines

Parish of St Matthew with St Paul, Winchester

St Paul's is operating its mainly outdoor sessions under the government guidelines for parent toddler groups. We will be meeting on Fridays from 9.30 to 11 am. We're only allowed 15 adults in attendance, plus volunteers. So please only turn up to a session if you have had your place confirmed by us beforehand.

Please read the information below before attending the session.

Before attending, all participants must self-assess themselves and their attending children for Covid-19 symptoms:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss of, or change to, their sense of smell or taste.

If you have one or more of these symptoms you should not attend and instead follow NHS and Public Health England guidance on self-isolation.

- Whilst in attendance social distancing should be maintained between *adults* and masks should be worn.
- Parents/carers should sign in by giving the supervising volunteer their name and contact number. These details will be kept for 21 days as a record of who has attended for contact-tracing purposes.
- There will be hand sanitiser available; please use some on arrival, departure and whenever you feel necessary during the session.
- Antibacterial wipes will also be available; please use these to sanitise any toys that your child has put in their mouth, sneezed on or touched with spitty fingers!
- If nappy changing or potty use is required, please ensure that this is carried out a reasonable distance from all the equipment.
- There will be drinks and snacks done in a Covid-safe way.
- If you have a positive Covid test result within one week of attending a session, please let us know.
